Coordinate with the Pastor to develop, lead, and direct weekly, blended worship services that include both traditional/gospel & contemporary music through inclusion of praise songs, hymns, choir, vocalists, musicians, and other special music.

Integrate and utilize various musical instruments, audio-visual equipment, & computers in worship services. An ability to lead with a guitar and/or keyboard along with piano accompaniment is a plus.

Help expand the music program to include students (Grades: Kindergarten-12) with occasional Sunday morning presentations & other special events.
